



Reminders

- * Recruitment for the Class of 2021 begins on *Friday, September 16th*. Remember that siblings who live in the same household and share at least one parent are not entered into the lottery if the application is submitted on time. Please stop by the front office for a sibling application.
- * Students who are medically noncompliant are at risk of being barred from school. Parents, schedule those appointments and send in your appointment cards as soon as possible.
- * Uniform can be purchased before and afterschool daily until *Monday, October 3rd*. Then we will only sell uniform articles on Monday mornings between 7:00a.m.-8:00a.m.
- * With this newsletter you can find a Student Reduced Fare Riding Privileges Renewal Form that Ventra is using to activate student reduced fare privileges on cards for the 2016-2017 school year. Be sure to submit this form directly to Ventra. New cards that are not programmed either can be purchased from the front desk for \$2. The same form will be given to students to submit to Ventra when new cards are purchased.
- * Be sure to call absences in to the front desk after 7:00a.m. Upon returning to school, student have 2 days to submit documentation in order to have an absence excused. This will allow students to make up work, including tests and quizzes. Please keep in mind that excused absences also count towards the Noble attendance policy count, as early dismissals and tardies do.
