Scholarly Updates

- The time is now to get grades where they need to be. Grades officially store at the end of the semester and effect cumulative GPA and class rank. Scholars should strive to get their GPA above a 3.5 in order to be eligible for scholarships their senior year. If scholars fail a course at the end of the semester they will be required to take night school or summer school at a fee.
