**Scholarly Updates**

- Report Card Pick Up (RCPU) for Quarter 3 is Friday, April 7th from 2:00p.m.-4:00p.m. and 5:00p.m.-7:00p.m. Mark your calendars and plan ahead. It is expected that 100% of parents attend RCPUs to talk with their scholar's advisor about their performance thus far. To avoid long lines please pay your bill in advance.
- Night school classes start at 4:00p.m. and end at 6:30p.m. Scholars can only miss two days of class. On the third absence, they will be dropped from the course and required to re-take the course during summer to promote to the next grade-level. No refunds will be issued.

**College Readiness – Class of 2018/Class of 2019**

- Sophomore and Junior trips are approaching fast! As a reminder, scholars must meet the following metrics to attend their trip:
  - 2018s: 2.5 and greater GPA, fewer than 15 detentions, fewer than 15 absences
  - 2019s: 2.0 and greater GPA, fewer than 20 detentions, fewer than 15 absences.
