### Scholarly Updates

- Report Card Pick Up (RCPU) for quarter 3 is Friday, April 7th from 2:00p.m. to 4:00p.m. and from 5:00p.m. to 7:00p.m. Mark your calendars and plan ahead. It is expected that 100% of parents attend RCPU to talk with their scholar's advisor about their performance thus far. To avoid long lines please pay your bill in advance.
- Night school classes start at 4:00p.m. and ends at 6:30p.m. Scholars can only miss two days of class. On the third absence they will be dropped from the course and required to re-take the course during summer to promote to the next grade-level. No refunds will be issued.
