- Report Card Pick Up (RCPU) for quarter 3 is Friday, April 7th from 2:00p.m. to 4:00 p.m. and from 5:00p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Mark your calendars and plan ahead. It is expected that 100% of parents attend RCPU to talk with their scholar's advisor about their performance thus far.
