Scholarly Updates

- The end of the school year will be here soon! 9th – 11th graders are expected to participate in something enriching over the summer. This can be a summer program, internship, or summer job. Plan ahead! Evidence of summer programming will be due to advisors on May 12th. Evidence can be in the form of a letter from an employer verifying employment, summer course schedule, payment for summer academy or summer school, etc. If you have any questions or concerns please reach out to your scholar's advisor.
- If your scholar fails a course during second semester or have a course they failed during 1st semester and did not take night school, they must take a summer course in order to promote to the next grade level. Every day courses cost \$140 and every other day courses cost \$100. Advisory and community service cost \$70.

- Summer Academy for 2020 and 2021s: July 10th - July 28th Period 1 8:00a.m. - 9:58a.m. Period 2: 10:02a.m. – 12:00p.m. Lunch: 12:00p.m. – 1:00p.m. Scholars in summer academy must take both periods.

 - 13-24 = 1 summer discipline class
 - 25-36 = 2 summer discipline classes
 - 37 plus = Does not meet promotion requirement

Community Service

- Senior lunch hours will be spent in room 710 if they are under 85 hours. Not reaching 100 hours will prohibit to attend senior activities.
- End of year requirements in order to avoid Community Service Summer School (course cost= \$70) is as follows: Freshman = 10 hours, sophomores = 30 hours, juniors = 60 hours and seniors = 100 hours.
- Hours for 2018s, 2019s, and 2020s are due June 15th

Enrichment

- Scholars continue to attend enrichment to avoid summer school credit recovery. Missing two or more enrichment classes result in being dropped.
- End of year enrichment requirements sophomores= .5, juniors= 1 credit and seniors 2 credits.
