

Reminders

- Post ACT Testing (End of Year) is on Wednesday, June 7th for 9th & 10th graders. On June 7th, juniors will be off campus on advisory service trips.
- Thursday, June 8th is a half day for all scholars due to 2017 Graduation! School starts for all scholars at the regular schedule. 9th and 10th grades dismiss at 11:55a.m. and 11th grade dismisses at 12:20p.m.
- On Friday, June 9th, juniors will be dismissed at approximately 2:30p.m. after their ACT luncheon.
- All juniors are taking the official ACT on Saturday, June 10th. Juniors MUST be at Muchin by 6:30a.m. on Saturday, June 10th. As always, attendance is mandatory on testing days.
- Report Card Pick Up (RCPU) for quarter 4 is Tuesday, June 20th from 2:00p.m.-4:00p.m. and 5:00p.m.-7:00p.m. Mark your calendars and plan ahead. It is expected that 100% of parents attend RCPU to talk with their scholar's advisor about their performance thus far. To avoid long lines, please pay your bill in advance. Any failed promotion requirement must be made up during the summer to be able to promote to the next grade-level. PowerSchool access is off for seniors and will turn off Wednesday June 7th for all other grades and remain off for the rest of the year.
- Muchin is hosting a meningitis vaccine clinic during quarter 4 report card pick up. All students 16 years or older and/or entering the 12th grade for the first time are encouraged to participate. Special permission slips invites will go out to students who fall in this category – due by June 9th to the front desk.

Scholarly Updates

- End of year senior events are quickly approaching. As a reminder, senior bills must be paid off in order to attend prom and seniors must be passing all graduation requirements. If you are interested in purchasing additional graduation tickets, tickets go on sale the week of June 5th and cost \$50 each. - Finals are right around the corner. Freshmen, sophomores, and juniors will take their finals Monday, June 12th - Wednesday, June 14th. Scholars who miss a final will receive a zero for the exam unless they have a note from a doctor excusing their absence. This rule also hold true for seniors: seniors who miss their senior research project presentation or their CLEP Standardized Test will receive a zero unless they have a doctor's note.
- If your scholar fails a course during second semester or have a course they failed during 1st semester and did not take night school, they must take a summer course in order to promote to the next grade level. Every day courses cost \$140 and every other day courses cost \$100. Advisory and community service cost \$70. Attendance class is \$25 for those who failed that requirement.
- Summer Credit Recovery: June 26th - July 12th Period 1: 8:00a.m. – 12:00p.m. Period 2: 12:30p.m. - 4:30p.m.
- Summer Academy for 2020 and 2021s: July 10th - July 28th Period 1 8:00a.m. - 9:58a.m. Period 2: 10:02a.m. – 12:00p.m. Lunch: 12:00p.m. – 1:00p.m. Scholars in summer academy must take both periods.
- Special note: Muchin will host two big group sessions for scholars. Session 1 (ladies): Tuesday, June 6th. Dismissal will be at 4:00p.m. Session 2 (gentlemen): Friday, June 9th during AMA.

Senior Week Activities:

Monday: Senior Brunch at Muchin in the MPR starting at 1:30p.m. Scholars should plan on arriving to Muchin no later than 1:15p.m. to ensure they are not late. At brunch seniors will get their cap and gowns and 4 tickets (3 more are available per student at a price of \$50 each). In order to receive tickets, students must have a zero balance on their bill.

Community Service

- Senior lunch hours will be spent in room 710 if they are under 85 hours. Not reaching 100 hours will prohibit to attend senior activities and/or walking across the graduation stage. Deadline for CS hours in order to attend prom is Friday, May 26th.
- End of year requirements in order to avoid Community Service Summer School (course cost= \$70) is as follows: Freshman = 10 hours, sophomores = 30 hours, juniors = 60 hours and seniors = 100 hours.
- Hours for 2018s, 2019s, and 2020s are due June 15th. This is a hard deadline, no extensions will be made.

Enrichment

- It is the end of the year and trimester 3 is officially over! All enrichment credit will be loaded into PowerSchool before the end of the school year.
- End of year enrichment requirements: sophomores= 0.5, juniors= 1 credit and seniors 2 credits.
