

Reminders

*Parents and Scholars, as you may have heard in the news, the Chicago Teachers' Union has voted and authorized a strike. Should the strike occur, Muchin will still be operating business as usual - the strike will **not** impact our teachers. Please continue sending scholars to school daily regardless of the potential strike.

*It has been brought to our attention that there was a Facebook post of clown threats. There have been many reports of similar social media postings involving schools around the country, but as with all concerns, we take all threats seriously. Noble immediately contacted the CPS Office of Safety and Security and began an investigation. We determined that the post was made by a student as a hoax and therefore, the threat has been deemed not credible. The safety of our staff and students is our top priority. If you have any questions or concerns about this matter, please contact the school. Parents, please also monitor your scholar's social media accounts to ensure he/she is not partaking in any inappropriate communication.

*On Friday, October 14th all 9th, 10th, and 11th graders will be taking the Q1 Interim Test. As always, attendance is extremely important especially on testing days. Please be sure your scholar arrives to school ON TIME!!!

College Readiness

*Seniors & Parents: ***MANDATORY* FAFSA Submission Workshop** – Saturday, October 8th, 10:00a.m.

Purpose: To submit the FAFSA with the help of FAFSA Professionals from the *Illinois Student Assistance Commission* organization. Both the parent & student need to have created an FAFSA ID before this date.

What to bring? 2015 Tax Return (1040) forms, parent and student FSA ID & password (*must be created at least 3 days prior to workshop in order to submit*). *Parents without a SSN: You will be unable to create an FSA ID. *Before students submit FAFSA information, they will print out a 'Parent Signature Page.' This must be signed by a parent/guardian and mailed to FAFSA. (FAFSA Professionals/College Counselors will help on day of the workshop). Already submitted FAFSA? Students must email Mr. Jackson their confirmation email in order to be excused from the workshop.

***First 2 College Applications are DUE October 13th and 14th.** One MUST be through the Common Application (this means, if you have not completely finished the common app, you must do so asap! Be sure to see college counselors before submitting any applications!)
