



Reminders

*Noble schools will be in session regardless of a strike at CPS or UCSN Charter Schools. Muchin College Prep will be open and classes will take place as normal. Your student is expected to be in school on time every day and your child's absence will result in loss of instructional time.

*On Friday, October 14th all 9th through 11th graders will be taking the Q1 Interim Test. Attendance is extremely important especially on testing days. Please be sure your scholar arrives to school ON TIME!!!

*Attention 2020 parents: Freshmen scholars will be dismissed at 1pm this Friday, October 14th after their freshmen shopping trip. After this Friday, freshmen scholars may shop downtown on Fridays only. As a reminder, scholars may never shop before or after school Monday to Thursday.

*On Wednesday, October 19th all 9th through 11th graders will be taking the PAST. This test is extremely important to all students who are preparing for college. Depending on scores, students can qualify for financial scholarships. As always, attendance is extremely important. Please be sure your scholar arrives to school ON TIME!!! School will be a full day schedule, except for seniors who should visit colleges or do community service. Seniors must provide proof of college visits or community service hours.

*The Hispanic Latino Heritage Month celebration will take place at Roosevelt University after the PSAT on October 19th for all 9th through 11th graders and scholars will be dismissed at the regular dismissal time.

*Josten's is coming on Friday, October 28th for ring sales for Seniors. If your senior purchases a ring, a deposit is due to Josten's by Friday, November 4th.
