- Friday, October 28th is College T-shirt Day! Represent your favorite college or university! But remember, full uniform from the waist down, including shoes and belt!

- The Federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires school districts to inform parents of their "right to ask" for the educational qualifications of their children's classroom teachers. Specifically, parents have a right to know: If their child's teachers have met state qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas they teach; If their child's teacher(s) are teaching under emergency or other provisional certificate status; Undergraduate degree major of the teacher and any graduate degree they may hold; Qualifications of any paraprofessionals providing services to their children. If you wish for any or all of the information, please contact the main office. Please be aware that certificate and ESSA qualification data for teachers will not be available until the second semester. At that time, parents who requested the information can pick up the information from the school. If you have any additional questions, please contact the Principal.
