Scholarly Updates

- Official grades do not store until Semester 1 RCPU. The grades on the Semester 1 Report Card will determine your cumulative GPA, class rank, and be seen by colleges and universities when you begin applying.
- Finals for Semester 1 will be Wednesday, January 17th through Friday, January 19th. Everyday courses have a two hour final and every other day courses have an hour final. Make sure you are studying! Finals are a large part of your grade and will be an even larger part of your grade in college.
- If you are absent from a final you will get a zero for that class unless you bring a note from a doctor clearing your absence.
- Night School signups will occur at Semester 1 RCPU. Any course that is failed must be made up in Night School or Summer School to promote to the next grade-level. Credit Recovery for every day courses cost \$140 and every other day courses cost \$100. Advisory credit recovery is \$70. Students who do not hit the semester 1 requirement for Community Service will also be required to attend Community Service Night School for \$70. Attendance recovery and discipline courses are only available during the summer. Attendance recovery and fitness courses are \$25 during the summer.
- Peer Tutors are available to assist scholars with homework and study skills. Reach out to Mrs. Powers (rpowers@muchincollegeprep.org) to be connected to a tutor.

Campus Culture

- There will not be detention on Friday, December 15th due to no school for scholars. Detention will be held on Thursday, December 21st from 3:50pm-5:50pm.
- Discipline Promotion Requirement Reminder:
 - 13-24 detentions = 1 summer discipline class
 - 25-36 detentions = 2 summer discipline classes
 - 37 plus = Does not meet promotion requirement scholar repeats grade level.
 - Please check in with your scholar regarding their detention count on a weekly bases.

If scholars need any documents re-sent, scholars should inform College Counselors via email or weekly check-ins.

College Readiness – Class of 2020

- **The Summer of a Lifetime Application DEADLINE for the 3-part application is DUE Thursday, December 14th.** The 3 parts include: **1.** SOL Online Application, **2.** Page 1 of Parent 1040 Tax Return (*if parent does not have tax return, they should bring in their Social Security document or Disability document from the government.*), and **3.** Signed Parent Permission Document/Contract. 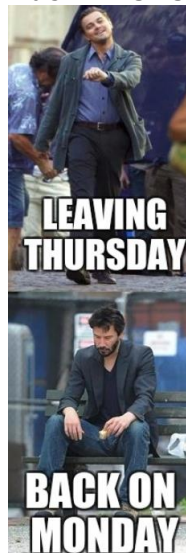
