Scholarly Updates

- Climber's Club for 9th and 10th graders below a 2.5 GPA requires scholars to attend office hours 4 days per week (Monday - Thursday). Not attending office hours to get the academic support to be successful will result in 4 demerits. Make sure you stay on top of your scholars academics before report card pick up.
- Parents, please make sure you are tracking your scholar's performance on PowerSchool. In order to login to PowerSchool you must have an account. Please reach out to your scholar's Dean of Students, Mr. Johnson (2021 & 2020) or Mrs. Powers (2018 & 2019), if you need assistance creating an account. All scholars have their own PowerSchool access account. Their username is "FirstName.LastName" and their password is their student ID number. As of today there are 277 scholars that have not logged in this school year.
